Dear Area Service Committee,

This will comprise a combination of the Here & Now Group and the Adhoc Policy & Procedure reports. The Here & Now Group Conscience met on Tuesday September 4, 2018. We conducted a lot of business in the hour allotted to us. Our meetings are going well with upwards of 40-50 addicts in attendance each week. There were 8 voting members present which was a damn sight improvement over the 2 members that we had for group conscience for years. Bobby was elected to chair the meetings for the month of September. Whitney H expressed the willingness to consider the position of Area Adhoc Public Relations Chairperson. She stated that she would download Area Guidelines and familiarize herself with the requirements and what was expected from that position. The group would revisit the matter at next month's group conscience.

The group elected to hold group conscience before the meeting rather than after. This was decided so no one; including addicts with children or those who had to drive long distances did not have to get out so late. We would continue to monitor this to see how it was working and revisit it again if it was not working.

The group discussed the matter of our meeting being closed and listed as such on the Area meeting schedule. There was much discussion on this issues as it related to addicts, treatment centers, recovery houses, and the general public. No decision was made at this time but discussion points would be provided to members who were unable to attend in order to reach a conscience on how we would proceed with the matter at next month's group conscience.

Matt D received an affirmative vote of support from the group in his election for Area Adhoc H & I Subcommittee Chairperson. Open positions at the group level are P & P and Activities.

Our group also wanted to let the Area know that we thought it was a good idea have a learning day about managing bank accounts in light of the new laws passed governing finance. In addition, we would like to see a workshop on how other groups conduct business in their group conscience. Our next home group meeting is October 2, 2018 before the regularly scheduled meeting. We are prepared to conduct business today.

The Adhoc Policy & Procedure Subcommittee has not met since the last Area meeting. However, we have acquired two copies of World H & I Guidelines for the Area Chairperson of that committee and a copy to keep for our own reference.
