Final Report to Area

June 9, 2024

Dear Family,

First I'd like to thank everyone from the South Central Area for coming together and making KRCNA such a wonderful and successful convention. The weekend was filled with unity, love, a whole lot of faith and trust, and commitment to carry the message of recovery to the still suffering addict. We were truly a blessed area to have had such an amazing convention.

The committee came together one last time on May 13 to wrap everything up. All members turned in all regional belongings and gave their final reports. The final total of funds that were turned over to our regional committee was \$16,024.86. We were originally given \$6,000 seed money to get things started. Thanks to many area fundraisers and the convention itself, we raised over \$10,000. Forty percent (\$4,000) of the profit will be sent to The World Service Office, and Sixty percent (\$6,000) will be kept by our Region. The KRCNA XXXVII bank account has been closed, and all cashier's checks have been mailed. They were received by our regional treasurer two days later.

The committee would like to express a great sense of gratitude for allowing us to serve our area. It was a long process, but also a journey full of worth and sense of purpose. Thank you for allowing us to serve.
