ASC RCM Report

Dear Family,

The review and input draft revision is available for IP #21 and will be included in the Conference Agenda Report for approval at the 2026 World Service Conference. This work is attempting to reach addicts in area that have no meetings yet, or can't get to meetings because of physical disabilities, caregiving, neurodivergence or mental health issues. The survey revealed that isolation is not just a geographic issue and there is no model for the recovering addict there is no single version of the addicts experience of staying clean in isolation. They dropped "The Loner" from the title and left "Staying Clean in Isolation" to be more inclusive.

If you want to look over the draft I have my copy and I can show you how to find it on the website. The World Board appreciated those that took the time to review the draft and share their input.

The Washington DC, World Convention of Narcotics Anonymous 38 Financial report has been released. The Expense over income was \$995,897. This may look like a huge loss, but the Message of Narcotics Anonymous was delivered to thousands of addicts and that is priceless. However, as a result, The World Board has decided to not have a World Convention in 2027. The future of the World Convention will be reviewed by the Board and more will be revealed.

KRCNA 38 reported approximately 149 preregistrations, 125 registered the day of the convention for a total of 274 participants. They have \$11,335.73 in the bank with one outstanding check to reconcile to the hotel for \$1573.26. and a couple of miscellaneous expenses to clear up. They are writing two checks to region, one for the \$6,000 return of the seed money and another for the rest when all is reconciled.

Our Regions current bank balance is \$24,288.02.

The PANA 2025 LBL flyer for Freedom Between the Lakes Campout on September 19th -21st has been circulated and will be posted on our website soon.

KRNA 39 Convention Chair requested the remaining \$5,500 seed money, check was written. Pre-convention registration has been made available online for \$25 at <https://kentuckianana.org/krcna-39/>.

Patty M. is now the Regional Chair moving up from the Vice Chair service position, leaving that position open. Nominations are open for Vice Chair and Treasurer.

The flyer has been circulated and will be posted on our website for the ATRA 7th annual RAW picnic for September 6th from 11-5 at the Henderson County Fairgrounds.


Dear Jailer Harmon,


