RCM report to Area
August 9, 2026

Dear Family,

Deb and I attended the regional meeting hosted by the Across the Rivers Area on Sunday, July 19.

There's a lot going on. So hold on! All areas were in attendance with the exception of Pennyrite and 502. Our treasurers report noted \$29,113.82 in our account with \$449.95 outgoing. These amounts are important for upcoming business so keep that in mind please. Our regional delegate Rodney B. reported the revision of IP # 21 was Fellowship approved, upcoming Southern Zonal Forums will be held July 24-26 in Sherman, Texas and October 2-4 in Wichita, Kansas.

The KRCNA 39 chair sent a final report noting a total of \$13,813.23 will be returned to region. \$6000 seed money and \$7813.23 profit. Those funds have not yet been received/deposited. Per regional policy 40% of that profit \$3125.29 is automatically donated to world service, that check was sent on August 7, 2026 by our treasurer. Our KRCNA 40 chair reports all service positions have been filled and they're currently working on finalizing the contract with the Holiday Inn East hotel.

Our project coordinator is currently working on budget changes, particularly related to our regional delegate expenses and regional delegate/regional delegate alternate terms of service of service. Since our world service conference is only held every three years and we alternate serving as lead delegate with the Bluegrass region, our terms of service are doubled. That means a six year term of service for an incoming regional delegate alternate. Figuring out how to make that work so the terms of service are not so overwhelming is a big part of what is being addressed. The RDA position is now officially vacant.

If you wish to attend a Regional meeting via Zoom, a new link will be posted on the regional website. An updated link will be posted on our Area website as well.

As far as Area reports, Across the Rivers is planning their first fundraiser for KRCNA, the Spanish Metro area hosted its first convention in Louisville July 24-26, can't wait to hear how that turned out. And here's the big one, Louisville area submitted a motion (number 07-01-26) to donate \$10,000 from the Region to the World Service Office. I will hand out copies of this motion so that you can take it back to your home group and vote on it. The intent of this motion is to lower our regional balance and further carry the message on a larger scale. So, with the outgoing funds noted from our regional account, we should have \$25,538.58 prior to receiving the KRCNA 39 funds. When those are received, our total is expected to be \$39,351.81. So if we approve motion 07-01-26 that would bring our balance right back to the \$29,000 mark.

The other big news is that by policy the KRCNA 41 chair nominations are supposed to be made in May so that they can be voted on in September of this year. The Pennyrite Area is next in the rotation, but their service rep did not attend the meeting, a call after the meeting to a member of Pennyrite Area service body revealed they will pass hosting duties for 2027. I completely freaked out because I thought we were next in line, we are not. It does mean the OVANA region will be hosting KRCNA 41 and the South Central Kentucky Area will be hosting KRCNA 42 in 2028. One year earlier than we expected. Time flies especially when a convention is on your doorstep, time to start planting the seeds now, please take that back to your home groups as well. Conventions are incredible opportunities for service work.

Our next regional meeting will be Sunday, September 20th, 1 PM central time at the Freedom Between the Lakes camp out.
