Treasurer's Report:

Current balance: \$30,142.32- 6 deposits were made totaling \$767.10 (see treasurer's report for more information). 2 withdrawals were made on 11/10/25 - \$1342.82 to WSC and 11/08/25 - Floyd County Token Club \$40 for rent on last regional meeting. The debit card expired but Zoom withdrew \$176.85. Patti had the new debit card. Joy agreed to bring it to Mark.

SCKY made a motion to accept and Louisville 2nd the motion. Motion passed

RD Report:

CAR is available on NA.org. CAT will be available on 2/3/26. The upcoming world convention for 2028 is in the planning stages. They are looking at a European location of either Portugal, Germany, or Ireland. Kevin D. reported not having the time or resources to attend the World Service Conference therefore Rodney B. will go in his place. He has agreed to remain in the position and assist with CAR/CAT workshops until the end of his service commitment. He expressed concerns over offering several times to develop a workshop to discuss a policy for KBARNA but has no support for this.

RDA Report:

Rodney has registered for the WSC. His expenses for attending the WSC will be submitted in the March regional meeting. He has requested a roommate at the conference in hopes of reducing the region's expenses. He sent a link for census information that needs to be completed by all area RCMs by 2/28/26. There was an issue with receiving RDA report through the email thread, but it was resolved. There is a planned CAR/CAT workshop scheduled during the KRCNA convention. The time slot has not been determined.
