RCM report to Area

June 14, 2026

Dear Family, We met in Louisville at Christ Cathedral on May 17, 2026 with Mark S serving as our chair person. Six regions were present ATRA and Owensboro were absent.

Our treasurer reported \$29,162.92 in the region bank account per the April 2026 statement.

Rodney B, our RDA attended the world service conference in California. I am including with my report a list updated by the world service body of adopted motions. If you would like to see all the motions that were proposed go to NA.org and click on the 2026 CAR /CAT drop-down menu and it will show all the proposed motions and the straw poll results dated April 22, 2026. Rodney also reported that 10 members of the world board were elected.

Larry, our KRCNA 40 chair reported 116 early bird registrations and they are currently working securing a hotel.

Louisville Area reports a robust public relations committee who have put literature, racks in 26 different locations. They will also be working with a local television station to have ads running and a bus ad campaign for 4 to 6 weeks around the city so the still suffering addict can find our fellowship. He also reports that LACNA 36 has acquired the Galt House hotel and the convention dates are to be January 15 through the 17th 2027 The biggest news out of the Louisville area that may affect our entire region is that one of the home groups put forth a motion to have our region sent \$10,000 to the WSO, so this may be coming to our area soon for a vote, more will be revealed.

OVANA is adding a new meeting and they are working on the Miracle in the Hills camp out which is set for August 7 through August 9.

PANA celebrated their area birthday in May and their campout committee is in full swing. The Freedom Between the Lakes campout will be the third weekend in September.

502 Area is looking to expand south of Louisville. They're currently reaching out to unaffiliated home groups in the Hardin and Meade County area and they are also working on the second annual Yippee Ki-yay campout. It will be Saturday, August 22 at the Horine Reservation, group site one, Jefferson Memorial Forest..

Metro Spanish area reports they will have their first Unity Convention and will have 22 Spanish-speaking and 11 English speaking workshops, they want to invite all of our areas to be a part of. The convention is July 23 to July 26. Flyers are on the Louisville area website.

Regional positions open are RDA and treasurer. In our new business, we discussed KRCNA 41 elections, Pennyryle Area will be the host area if they accept. We also voted to purchase 20 basic texts 15 in Spanish and 5 in English to donate to the Spanish Metro area convention.
