Our area service meeting continues to meet the first Tuesday of each month on Zoom.

Our area home groups continue to meet mostly on Zoom. We also have 2 in person meetings, one of which is a hybrid meeting. In person meetings continue to do social distancing, no hugging, no coffee, no food, and limits the meeting room to 20 members. When the room gets too full, which has happened a couple of times recently, experienced members leave to allow newcomers to take their seats. Limit at present is 20.

Donations continue to be down, but rents are being paid. Group attendance on Zoom is down. We often have participation from NA members out of state. Home groups have distributed a number of the gifted Basic Texts from region; several have gone to addicts in the DMZ – areas between our two regions. As we are on the edge of Kentuckiana Region, this is to be expected. We often have addicts in our meetings and in contact with us who are currently in or from the Bluegrass Appalachian Region.
